

### Student Achievements

We were delighted to see so many of our students do well in the recent Bebras challenge. Students competed online in this computational thinking challenge that is set by Oxford University and Google. All students participated during their computing lessons in early November and 46 achieved a distinction for their age group - they will be bringing their certificates home this week. Of these 46 students, 12 scored in the top 10% across the country. A huge well done to Oscar, Becky, Freddie C, Lexi, Chloe, Poppy S, Ruairi, Joanne, Rory, Max, Oliver G and Anna C. They have been invited to participate in a further online challenge set by Oxford University in March 2020.



Next week all our students will be taking part in #HourOfCode, as part of Computer Science Week. This marks the start of their first coding unit in Computing, which stretches into the Spring term.


