With Manor Adventure to Norfolk Lakes
6th November 2024 - 8th November 2024

Katherine Warrington School would like to invite all of our new Year 7 students to take part in our Manor Adventure Norfolk Lakes trip. We aim to encourage our students to give their personal best and to work well as a team. Our Year 7 students have the opportunity to take part in a three-day/two-night residential adventure which will provide a fantastic chance to build new friendships and for taking early steps in developing invaluable leadership skills. The trip will challenge resourcefulness, creativity and teamwork, leaving students with a real sense of achievement, greater confidence and a new group of friends.

The trip will be run by Manor Adventure, an outdoor specialist. The students will be staying in apartments on site and in a range of outdoor pursuits from the following options - Abseiling, archery, climbing, high ropes, obstacle courses, kayaking, raft building, survival skills and zip wire.

Manor Adventure will be presenting at our parents information evening on Tuesday 4th July to provide further information on the trip and the activities the students will be getting involved in.

Students will depart from school on Wednesday 6th November at the normal start time (08:30) and will return to school at approximately 4:00pm on Friday 8th November.

The cost of this trip will be **£230**. This price includes travel, full board, accommodation, all activities/instructors, evening activities and insurance (please note personal items such as mobile phones, iPods and cameras are not permitted on this trip and are not covered under the school's insurance policy).

The full payment deadlines for this trip are as follows:

Wednesday 10th July 2024 - £50 deposit to secure your place on the trip.

The remaining balance of £180 can be paid in instalments to suit your family circumstances but must be paid in full by **Monday 16th September 2024**.



Payments can be made by logging in to Arbor under the trips section on the home page named 'Manor Adventure 6th-8th November 2024'. **(PLEASE IGNORE THE TRIP DATES ON ARBOR - THESE WILL CHANGE WHEN THE ACADEMIC YEAR ROLLS OVER)** The £50 deposit must be paid against this payment item by Wednesday 10th July 2024 to secure your place.

Kit List

We do stress that it is not necessary to go out and buy all new and expensive kit to come on our trips.

ESSENTIALS:

- A freshly laundered sleeping bag and pillow with pillowcase
- A drink bottle
- Torch (for evening walk)
- Rucksack
- Toiletries etc (please note deodorants must be roll-on, no aerosols)
- Old clothes for activity sessions - (long-sleeved shirts/jumpers, trousers / jogging bottoms (Not denim jeans) T-Shirts and closed-toe shoes are required for nearly all sessions so bring plenty).
Clothes, shoes and underwear for other times
- Waterproof clothing (jacket / trousers)
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Bath towels x 2
- Hat & Gloves in the winter
- Sunglasses, sun cream and hat in the summer
- Pyjamas and slippers
