- For all morning exams, students must be in the sixth form area by 8.30am (exams start at 9am)/ For afternoon exams (Mon-Thurs) students must be in the sixth form area by 1.00pm (exams start at 1.30pm)
- Friday afternoon students must be in the sixth form area by 12.30pm & exams will begin at 1.00pm.
- All the exams will take place in classrooms which will be confirmed closer to the exam week. The exams will be externally invigilated and all JCQ requirements will be followed.
- Students will have study leave for the week and will just be required to come in for their exams.
- CTEC/BTEC students will take their modular exams in May. Study leave will only be given to CTEC and BTEC students who are completely up to date with their work. Students who are behind with any of their assignments will be expected to attend school to catch up and improve on work.
- Friday 19th June is the new year 12 sixth form induction day. Unless students have an exam or have been asked to help with the sixth form induction day they will not be expected in school.
- Students with access arrangements will be spoken to individually closer to the exam week.
- A reminder that students will require at least a grade D in their end of year exam to ensure a smooth transition into year 13. Please ensure you utilise the time you have over the Easter break and into May to prepare as thoroughly as possible for these exams.
