Electives

Select 3 choices, in your order of preference.



Competitive Universities

Explore application strategies for highly selective universities in the UK and internationally. Sessions may include preparation for admissions tests, super-curricular development, and advice on building a strong academic profile. Students will also discuss subject exploration and ways to demonstrate intellectual curiosity beyond the classroom.

Y12 Oxbridge Applications

Designed for students considering applying to Oxford or Cambridge. The programme supports preparation for admissions tests, interviews, and personal statements. Students will explore super-curricular reading and practice discussing their subject in greater academic depth.

Silent Reading / Book Club

A quiet, focused environment where students can read a range of literature, both art and science-based.

UCAS Support

Guidance and support for completing the UCAS university application process. Students receive help with personal statements, course research, and meeting application deadlines. Sessions also provide advice on making informed decisions about university and future pathways.

Life Skills

Develop practical skills useful for life beyond school. Topics may include budgeting, time management, communication, and personal wellbeing. The sessions aim to build confidence and independence as students prepare for university or employment.

Silent Revision

A quiet, focused environment where students can complete independent study. This time can be used for revising course material, completing assignments, or preparing for exams. It encourages productive study habits and effective time management.

Mentoring

A chance to impart wisdom and guidance to the younger year groups in the school, such as advice about revising, exams or just general tips on navigating school life. If you choose to be a mentor, this will count as your only P7 option
